

# Call for Manuscripts



The Georgia Business Education Association invites the submission of manuscripts for publication consideration in the nationally peer-reviewed 30<sup>th</sup> edition of the Georgia Business Education Association Journal. The dual-format print/electronic journal is listed as a “commendable publication” in the Cabell’s Directory of Publishing Opportunities in Educational Curriculum & Methods and Educational Psychology & Administration.

## Aims and Scopes of the Journal

Manuscripts should be focused on practical topics, including business education/training/development-related teaching tips; research; and/or theory. Manuscripts must be of interest at primary, secondary, and/or post-secondary schools/college/universities.

## Manuscript Submission Guidelines

1. Manuscripts must
  - a. align with the aims and scopes of the journal.
  - b. conform to the publication style of the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, including:
    - i. A running head.
    - ii. A title page that includes the author(s) name; position; affiliation; mailing address; phone; and email.
    - iii. An abstract of less than 150 words.
    - iv. Approximately 1500-4000 words formatted with 12pt. Times New Roman font.
    - v. Appropriately formatted and essential tables and figures.
  - c. Be submitted
    - i. exclusively, not under other publication consideration, to the Georgia Business Education Association Journal.
    - ii. in Microsoft Word 2010 or later format.
    - iii. electronically, via email ([gbeajournal@gmail.com](mailto:gbeajournal@gmail.com)).

Manuscripts submitted by **December 1, 2011** will be granted full consideration for the 30<sup>th</sup> edition of the journal. Authors of manuscripts accepted for publication will be notified on or before February 28, 2012.
