An applicant's career objective must be business, business education, computer science/computer information systems, or a related field.

- A. A copy of your resume. Be sure to include your involvement, activities, and responsibilities in BPA or FBLA/PBL; business/computer courses taken, and work experience.
- B. A one-page keyed letter describing why you are deserving of this scholarship, defining your career goals, and including any information regarding financial need.
- C. Two letters of recommendation (principal, teacher/professor, advisor, counselor, employer, community leader, etc.)
- D. Copy of your college transcript.

The recipient of the scholarship shall each be awarded \$500: \$250 in the fall and \$250 in the spring. To receive \$250 in the fall, the recipient must submit proof of registration at an institution of higher learning. To receive \$250 in the spring, the recipient must submit a grade report and proof of registration.
